



Admissions at The Hollies School

Entry into The Hollies School is via the Local Authority (LA).



Children who require a special school placement are placed on the Pupil Admission List.



A multi-disciplinary panel meeting is held by the LA to discuss the needs of each child.



The LA advises parents on visiting the special schools. Parents are welcome to make an appointment to visit The Hollies where they will be given a tour of the school and can discuss the needs of their child and what the school has to offer.



If parents decide that they wish their child to have a place at The Hollies School then the Local Authority will make the necessary arrangements if a place is available. All pupils require a statement of special educational needs specifying Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).



Cardiff will inform you of your child's placement.



The Hollies School will then be in touch.



The Hollies will be in touch to arrange transition (Getting to know me) visits to the school in the summer term.



Parents will complete admissions pack and any other relevant information.



Photos will be provided of the staff and key areas of the school to help prepare your child.
